Dear Parents,

As you are aware next Friday (20th October) is the Boorowa Touch/Netball Carnival. The details for those students catching the bus are as follows:

Travel	:	Bus (with seat belts)
Leave School	:	6:45 am (<i>Be at school approx. 6.30am</i>)
Return to School	:	5:30 pm Approx.

We will be leaving school on time so please do not be late.

We will arrive at Boorowa with only minutes to spare and each team will need to be quickly taken to their first game. If there is no team adult on the bus, then the coach/manager will meet you at the Rosary Primary School marquee upon arrival at Boorowa.

Coaches and managers are responsible for their team's supervision on the day and the teachers will be roaming throughout the day to take care of any behavioural problems, first aid and any other issues that may arise. All parents assisting at the carnival, whether coming on the bus or driving themselves must have a current Working with Vulnerable People (WWVP) card.

It is important that the children wear their Rosary Sports Uniform and bring with them a jacket, a hat, sunscreen, a blanket to sit on, a water bottle, wet weather gear in case of rain and enough food to get them through a long day.

Children who suffer from asthma, hayfever etc. will need to bring their own medication. We **will not** be collecting kits from the front office.

If needed, an updated Boorowa draw and timetable will be sent home to the team coaches on Thursday afternoon and spare draws will be taken to the carnival on Friday for team managers. Coaches/Managers: Netball kits will be returned to school after this weekend's Catholic School's Netball Carnival. They will be available to collect on Thursday the 19th. If they are not collected they will be taken to Boorowa on the bus. We will also bring a set of touch footballs with us.

A big THANK YOU to Mick George for offering to set up our shade shelter. Any other parents who arrive early and can assist Mick with this would be appreciated. The accompanying teachers will receive all relevant information, such as updated draws etc. before the carnival begins and will ensure that all managers and coaches know where their games are.
