## Term 3 Overview - Kinder

### Religion

Students will identify Jesus as the Son of God, part of a loving family and a good friend. They will be encouraged to share love with their families and friends with Jesus as their example.

### English

Students will:

- discuss the purpose and features of different texts
- learn about simple functions of the keyboard, mouse and Ipad
- discuss new vocabulary found in texts
- understand how to use knowledge of letters and sounds to spell words
- recognise that there are storytellers in all cultures
- identify favourite authors and illustrators
- share feelings about events and characters in texts
- recognise the meaning of symbols in everyday contexts
- use digital technology to retell events
- participate in class discussions
- listen to, remember and follow simple instructions.

### Maths

Students will:

- use a range of practical strategies when solving simple addition, subtraction and division problems
- understand that halves are two equal parts
- link halving with subtraction by taking away half of a whole group
- skip count by 2s
- model and represent partitioning of numbers 10-20
- make representations of familiar 2D shapes
- identify the attribute of area as the measure of the amount of surface
- compare two areas directly.

### Science

Students will:

- understand that objects have observable properties and can be grouped based on these properties
- describe familiar materials and share information about familiar properties
- select appropriate materials to construct buildings and shelters
- use drawings to represent their observations and ideas.

### Humanities and Social Sciences

Students will:

- build on their knowledge and understanding of how the past is different from the present
- recognise that the past is communicated through stories passed down from generation to generation
- order significant personal events, using drawings and simple statements.

## Technologies

The students will explore the characteristics and properties of materials to design and create various shelters. Through this process they will develop new uses for various household objects.

### Health and Physical Education

Students will:

- demonstrate practices and protective behaviours to keep themselves safe on and near roads
- explore different fundamental movement sequences using different body parts
- explore how to play games safely.

### The Arts

Students will:

- learn about the techniques, processes and materials, Paul Klee and Aboriginal and Torres Strait Islander Peoples use to create art and use this knowledge to create their own art, inspired by these artists
- experiment with technology to capture and sequence images and texts to create a digital story
- practise and present a dance routine to the school community
- continue to develop their understanding of beat, rhythm and pitch through the use of movement and singing. They will also identify and record rhythms using simple notation.

### Indonesian

Students continue to explore how languages connect us to others by talking about the languages we can speak and investigating the features of a conversation. Students will practise a simple conversation in Indonesian, using different terms of address for adults and children.
