## Term 4 Overview - Kinder

### Religion

The students are encouraged to develop a personal relationship with God through many different forms of prayer. They will talk and listen to God through formal and informal prayer and understand that Scripture helps us to listen to God.

### English

Students will use predicting and questioning strategies to make meaning from texts. They will understand that there are different texts and identify connections between texts and their own personal experiences.

Students will continue to draw on their knowledge of concept of print, decoding and self-monitoring strategies to read various texts. They will listen for rhyme, letter patterns and sounds in words to assist the reading and writing process.

They will also use appropriate interaction skills to listen and respond to others.

### Maths

Students will develop their understanding that fair sharing means all shares are equal. They will count in multiples and make and count equal groups to solve multiplication and division problems.

Students will use direct and indirect comparisons to compare the capacity of containers in practical situations. They will explore and manipulate the many 3D objects around them and use their own language to describe these objects.

Students will also be given the opportunity to consolidate learning in all mathematical strands covered during their first year of school.

### Science

Students will understand the way objects move, depend on a variety of factors, including their size and shape. They will work in groups to describe what they have done and what they have found out. They will also use drawings to also represent their observations and ideas.

### Humanities and Social Sciences

Students will describe how the globe is a representation of the world and will locate Australia and other places on a globe. They will also explore places of cultural and historical significance to the Aboriginal community in our local area.

## Technologies

Students will explore how to manipulate materials using a range of tools, equipment and techniques to create movement. They will also record the procedure for making a product.

### Health and Physical Education

Students will describe how their body is growing and changing. They will identify and describe emotional responses people may experience in different situations and they will group foods into categories such as food groups.

The students will also participate in play that promotes engagement with the natural environment and they will practise a range of water and skipping skills.

### The Arts

Students will rehearse and perform sequences of ideas to communicate stories through drama.

They will identify, produce and present various media artworks for a particular purposes and they will follow technical processes and safe practices to make artworks.

Students will also sing and play music to explore the expressive possibilities of their voices and instruments. They will imitate pitch and rhythm patterns to develop aural recognition skills.

## Indonesian

Students will investigate how language and culture are connected in our family life by learning about Fenty and her daily life. Fenty is a primary school-aged student living in the Maluku islands of Indonesia. Students will also learn about the geography of Indonesia and will be able to recognise and use simple vocabulary to describe school and home.
